If you are caring for someone who is currently in hospital, you may find this a very worrying and stressful time.

St Helens and Knowsley

If you are the main carer, we want you to know that you have the right to stay with the person you care for throughout the day or night on our ward.

However, we understand that this may not be possible for all carers and should not be seen as a duty or responsibility.

How can we help?

If you are a carer for someone on the ward, please tell a member of our staff.

They will be able to give you a 'Forget me not' card.



The details on the 'Forget me not' card will help us to understand and remember what is important to the person who is being cared for.

The staff on the ward will also be able to give you a 'carers' pass'.

If you show this pass to 'The Spice of Life' restaurant staff, you will receive discount at the till for your food and beverages.

Parking

Concessions are available to patients and visitors that are required to regularly attend either hospital. A weekly pass costing £12 can be purchased. These passes will have unlimited use for a full 7 day period.

Support Services

Caring for someone can be rewarding but also difficult, and it is important that you as a carer receive the correct support.

If you are a carer please let a member of staff know. There are lots of things we can do to help support you including completing a carers passport.
