## **Discharge Information**

Your surgery today was to remove the lesion on your eye.

A chalazion (eyelid cyst, also known as a meibomian cyst) is a cyst in the eyelid.

A papilloma is a benign tumour or growth that arises from epithelial tissue.

This may be sent to the laboratory for analysis.

- If you have an eye pad, leave it on until ...... this will help reduce bruising and swelling.
- Your eye may look bruised and sore. You may take simple analgesia such as paracetamol. Please follow the instructions on the label.
- If your eye is sticky or needs cleaning, bathe gently with cool boiled water from inner to outer corner, using sterile gauze.
- If you have been given eye ointment, please apply as instructed with a clean finger-tip or directly on the wound and gently apply to the area where the stitches are (if applicable). Please remember to wash your hands first before touching or treating the eyes.

## **Discharge Information**

- Avoid strenuous exercise or heavy lifting following your surgery. Depending on your job, you may need some time off work.
- Avoid rubbing or touching the eyes with a used tissue.
- Avoid putting your head in a drooped position as that may increase the risk of swelling and bleeding.
- If any bleeding occurs, apply direct pressure. If it does not stop, seek medical advice.

You will be sent a follow up if required.

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
