#### **Cystic Fibrosis (CF) Clinic**

This is held every Monday afternoon in Paediatric Outpatients, Level 2, Whiston Hospital.

In order to reduce the risk of cross-infection, we run a segregated clinic, which means that each patient is given a specific time slot and allocated their own room for the duration of the appointment. At each clinic, your child will have their height and weight taken and be seen by one of our two paediatric consultants, a paediatric respiratory nurse, a dietitian and a physiotherapist.

#### Annual review/ interim review

Once per year, all children will have an annual review appointment whereby you will be seen by your Whiston team and Alder Hey team together.

Prior to this appointment you will be required to have the following investigations completed for your child, such as an ultrasound scan, chest x-ray and blood tests etc.

The annual review process will be explained in detail by the paediatric respiratory nurses. The two teams work closely to ensure your child has the best possible care over the coming years. Approximately 6 months after annual review, an interim review will be completed. You may not have to physically attend and you will receive a letter from the team to say we have discussed your child at a meeting and any changes to their plan will be explained.

#### **Inpatient care**

If your child needs to come into hospital for blood tests these will be carried out by the paediatric day unit.

If you have any concerns regarding your child, you have open access to the hospital via 0151 430 1627. You can contact this number for advice any time day or night.

#### In an emergency you must always call 999.

Inpatient admissions will be on the paediatric unit and your child will be nursed in a cubicle throughout their stay.

We do allow one parent/carer to stay overnight with their child whilst they are an inpatient.

We will work with you to organise any planned admissions for intravenous antibiotics to lessen the interruption to your normal routine.

Where possible, we will try to utilise Hospital@Home enabling your child to have the antibiotics administered in your own home.
