How can the Psychology team support you?

Pre-surgical Assessment

The Tier 4 Bariatric service is made up of many different professionals, including Psychologists. You may be asked to meet with one of the Psychologists in the team.

What will happen?

You will be asked to provide your email address during your initial nurse appointment. A Psychologist will then email you with a questionnaire to complete online. All patients are sent this questionnaire.

As part of the pre-surgical pathway, you may be invited to attend a one-to-one appointment with a Psychologist. This will be held online over a videocall.

The purpose of this appointment is to explore your request for surgery. This will include:

- The impact that your weight is having on you and your life
- The lifestyle changes you have already made
- How you hope surgery will change your life
- Your understanding of what the surgical procedure involves (including risk)
- How you intend to manage your recovery from surgery.

Pre-surgical Support

Following the assessment appointment you may be offered up to three appointments with a Psychologist and signposted to online self-help materials. These will help you to prepare for surgery and the lifestyle changes you need to make after surgery. These are freely available to all patients. See the back page of this leaflet for more details.

Or, you may be advised to seek additional support from an external organisation if your needs cannot be met by our Psychology team.

Post-surgical Support

All patients are sent another questionnaire from the Psychology team following surgery. You may also be offered brief psychological support to help with adjusting to and becoming comfortable with diet, lifestyle, or body-image changes that happen after surgery.

What does Psychological support mean?

The Psychology team will help you to identify how your thoughts and feelings may be affecting your weight. They will work with you to develop coping strategies for emotional eating behaviours and help you with making lifestyle changes.
