# **REQUEST**

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request the following information from <u>St Helens and Knowsley Hospitals NHS Trust</u>: **Staff numbers** 

- Number of staff working in the whole Trust as at 1<sup>st</sup> March 2020.
- Number of staff working in the Accident and Emergency department as at 1<sup>st</sup> March 2020.
- Number of staff working in the Intensive Care Unit as at 1<sup>st</sup> March 2020.

### Sick leave due to COVID-19

- Percentage of staff who took sick leave due to confirmed or suspected COVID-19 across the whole Trust during March 2020, April 2020, May 2020, June 2020, July 2020, August 2020 and September 2020 i.e. monthly sickness absence figures for COVID-19 between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 30<sup>th</sup> September 2020.
- Percentage of staff working in the Accident and Emergency department who took sick leave due to confirmed or suspected COVID-19 during March 2020, April 2020, May 2020, June 2020, July 2020, August 2020 and September 2020 i.e. monthly sickness absence figures for COVID-19 between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 30<sup>th</sup> September 2020.
- Percentage of staff working in the Intensive Care Unit who took sick leave due to confirmed or suspected COVID-19 during March 2020, April 2020, May 2020, June 2020, July 2020, August 2020 and September 2020 i.e. monthly sickness absence figures for COVID-19 between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 30<sup>th</sup> September 2020.

## **COVID-19 antibody tests**

We understand that all NHS organisations were required to carry out COVID-19 **antibody** testing of all employees during summer 2020.

 Please can you confirm the date range for your routine COVID-19 antibody routine screening tests.

### In addition:

- Across the whole Trust, how many staff were positive for COVID-19 antibodies on routine screening tests.
- For staff working in the Accident and Emergency department how many staff were positive for COVID-19 antibodies on routine screening tests.
- For staff working in the Intensive Care Unit how many staff were positive for COVID-19 antibodies on routine screening tests.

Please provide the information in the form of an Excel spreadsheet.

### **RESPONSE**

Under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act St Helens & Knowsley Teaching Hospitals Trust does not have to comply with a request if we estimate that the cost of complying with your request would exceed the appropriate limit of £450.
