I would like to know the number of cycles you have been using on the PCR (polymerase chain reaction) test as standard and if that number has ever been changed for what ever reason?

The analyser used are based on real time PCR analysis which is not contingent on a defined number of cycles (as in standard PCR), but rather at what cycle does the amplification curve cross a certain diagnostic threshold. For each instrument these limits of detection have been identified as part of the UKAS accredited validation and verification process. There have been no changes made.

i would also like to know how many children under the age of 16 have been logged as a death from SARSCoV2 without any under lying health issues.
