9. How many on site nutritious food options are there? **Nutritious options are available in the restaurant and in all vending facilities**
10. Is hot food available 24 hours a day? **Yes hot vending facilities available.**

**We have 27 plumbed in water machines and free water machines in both restaurants.**
13. Do you routinely provide free tea and coffee making facilities for staff in clinical areas? **Yes**
14. How many staff lockers and secure storage areas do you have? **98 secure staff rooms with sufficient lockers for staff who wear a uniform.**
15. Do staff have access to on site changing facilities 24 hours a day? **YES**
16. Do staff have access to on site showering facilities 24 hours a day? **YES**
17. Are rest facilities available to staff if too tired to drive home following a night shift? **YES**
18. How many staffroom or 'mess' facilities are there on site? **98 approx.**
19. Do you have any dedicated outdoor space for staff? **The Trust has extensive and beautiful grounds at both main hospital sites for staff, patients' and visitors' enjoyment.**
20. What welfare and wellbeing services are available to staff? **Staff have access to a Trust in house Health, Work and Wellbeing Service, which is an Occupational Health speciality. The Trust also provides a range of other services and facilities to support staff wellbeing, such as financial advice, counselling, fitness and social activities (when social distancing guidance allows). A range of staff wellbeing services are available.**
21. Is psychological support routinely offered to staff? **Yes through Health, Work and wellbeing Services to staff.**
22. Does the trust organise Balint groups or Schwartz rounds for all staff? **No not formally but there are de-briefs and support available following traumatic or stressful events.**
