#### **RESPONSE**

## QI/Clinical Audit Dept. (QICA)

QICA deals with QIPs and Clinical Audit Projects: from Oct-2020 to present we have registered over 200 projects (N207); our area of work is primarily focused on projects reviewing clinical treatment, care and procedures: however one Anaesthetic project was related to sustainability:

 Promoting sustainable anaesthesia: We need to talk about "Des". (Desflurane)

# **Service Improvement Projects**

Out of 36 projects that have been undertaken or have started since October 2020 we have assessed that 8 of these have an environmental/sustainability agenda as part of the project. When we have classified a project as having a sustainability agenda we have considered aspects such as avoiding a need for unnecessary appointment, minimizing travel or reducing paper usage.

## Research Dept. (RDI)

The Trust have 17 active research projects registered with us within the specified time period. None of these relate to sustainability in healthcare research.
