DBS checks are mandatory in the NHS for all staff, as a condition of their employment. The level of check required will be determined by the position. Candidates who require a DBS check are also required to sign up for the DBS update service within 30 days of their DBS check being completed to allow us to regularly check the service for any changes to an individual's status.
