Subject: burden of mental health admissions

REQUEST

I would like to obtain information on any adult patients who have been admitted to hospital from A&E (not A&E attendances themselves, only those who are admitted to medical beds) from 01/08/21 to 31/07/2022.

Ideally the information would include age, gender, dates of admission, diagnosis and whether the psychiatric diagnosis was their presenting complaint, or a comorbidity i.e. had been admitted with an unrelated problem but also had a known mental health condition. I do not wish to obtain any personal identifiable details.

These will likely be based on the ICD F0-F99 codes but EXCLUDING learning / intellectual difficulties (F70-F89) and disorders of psychological development. I only require information on those aged 18 and over.

Would it also be possible to be given the data (inc. age / gender / month of admission) for all patients admitted to hospital in that time so that I can calculate the proportion of all admissions who had a mental health disorder?
