

Transition to Adult Service on Ward 3A Information for Young People and their carers

As you have now reached the age where you will go onto our adult ward (Ward 3A), we want to ensure that you and your family or carers are prepared to make things as comfortable as possible for you.

The Ward Environment

When you come to Whiston Hospital as an inpatient you will now go to Ward 3A. It is a very friendly yet busy ward. There will be patients of all ages, some having had accidents or others who are poorly. You will have a named nurse who will look after you during your stay. Please let them know if you have any needs or concerns and they will reassure you.

Having your parent or carer with you

We understand that its important for you to have your family or carers with you. You may be staying on a ward with other patients and if that's the case, only a relative of the same sex can stay in that room. If you are female and you need a male family member with you we can arrange for you to have a side room ,but we need to know this in advance, so please let us know as soon as possible.
