# St Helens and Knowsley Teaching Hospitals NHS Trust

**Patient Profile Report 2022** 

#### Introduction

This report looks at the demographics of the patients who accessed the services the Trust provided during the 12-month period from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to 31st December 2022. It provides information on the demographics of the Trust's local populations and compares this to the demographics of the patients accessing the Trust's services. The report looks at both inpatient admissions and outpatient attendances throughout this 12 month period.

The population served by the Trust resides principally in four different local authority areas, St Helens, Knowsley, Halton and Liverpool. The majority of patients (75%) reside in St Helens and Knowsley (50% and 25% respectively). In all areas it is predicted that the elderly population will grow significantly over the next 10 years. This ageing local population is likely to increase the incidence of diseases linked to older age and potentially increase demands on health and social care services across all four local areas.

#### 2021 census – population changes:

Data from all three of the local populations we serve have shown an increase in population size:

**Knowsley** the population has grown by 5.9% (which is higher than he growth in the growth rate in the whole of the Northwest.

With a 13.8% increase in the number of residents aged 65+ years.

**St Helens** population grew by 4.5%.

With a 19.7% increase in the number of residents aged 65+ years

Halton had a much smaller growth increase, of only 2%

In comparison to both St Helens and Knowsley although the population growth is much smaller the increase in the 65+ years age group is much higher at 29.3%.

The percentage of patients in every age group except 86-90 year olds has remained almost identical to those seen in the 2020 and 2021 reports despite the yearly increase in the number of inpatients.

There was a slight increase (2%) in patient in the 86-90 years age group in 2021 which has returned to near the 4.4% seen in 2020.

The highest number of inpatients are in the 71-75 year age group, and has been in previous years.

White British again makes up the majority of our inpatients in 2022 with 90% identifying White British, which is very similar to the percentages seen in our local communities.

5% of inpatients did not have their ethnicity recorded (not stated and not set) which is a huge improvement on previous years where the numbers of patients who did not have this field completed.
